

Your Board is proposing two bylaw amendments to the National Board to make changes to the National By-Laws. They concern items that we want to bring to your attention. Before we propose these amendments to National, our members need to vote on them at the November meeting.

We will need approval from our branch and from 17 other branches before they can be formally introduced as by-laws to be taken into consideration nationally. If you are unable to attend the November meeting and wish to vote, you may send your vote to Prue Carrico, Co-President.

DRAFT OF BYLAW AMENDMENTS

ARTICLE III: MEMBERSHIP

Section 1: Types of Membership

E. Emerita Membership: When a member achieves the age of 90 + years, or when it becomes difficult for the member to continue in active participation in Branch events, the Board will award her the status and title of Pen Woman Emerita. Thereafter, Branch, State, and National dues

are no longer collected.

An Emerita Pen Woman may continue to enjoy all privileges of a regular member, as long as she continues to submit an annual membership information form to the Branch Treasurer. The cost for a subscription to *The Pen Woman* magazine to Pen Women Emeritae will be borne by the sponsoring branch.

The second amendment is to avoid duplication of dues collection in the same year.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

Section 3. ANNUAL DUES, PROCESING FEES, AND FISCAL YEAR

C. It is proposed that membership applications submitted from September through

November be considered, processed, and informed by January 1 of the following year.

New applicants from January 1 shall not be admitted before February 15.

This is to avoid duplication of dues payments in one calendar year.

Those members admitted February 15 or later will not be required to pay dues until the following dues year.
