

REPORT OF ACTIVITES FOR 2014-15, 2015-16 Year Total Membership this year is 60 Members. We are the second largest branch in the country.

In 2015, we awarded three Art Scholarships totaling \$2,700 from our Dori Popenoe Art Fund.
