



Sharon Koskoff is an accomplished artist, known for hundreds of decometric public murals and art installations throughout Palm Beach County. As an Art Deco afficionado, Sharon is the founding president of the Art Deco Society of the Palm Beaches, established in 1987. Her two published books – *Art Deco of the Palm Beaches* and *Murals of the Palm Beaches* – document the architecture and art that Sharon works tirelessly to preserve.



Sharon combines her art talent with her teaching skills, instructing classes at the Armory Art Center in West Palm Beach and the School of Creative Arts in Delray Beach. She has also taught classes and workshops at the Norton Museum of Art, the Boca Museum of Art, the Palm Beach Institute of Contemporary Art, and at local colleges and universities.

As a preservationist, Sharon is passionate about saving Art Deco architectural gems in the Palm Beach area. She is a frequent lecturer and popular tour guide who ushers groups through historic areas of Palm Beach.

After earning a BA degree from Brooklyn College in New York, Sharon earned a second degree in color theory from the New York School of Interior Design. While living in New York, she started her own company, New York Neddlecraft, creating unique Art Deco geometric designs in needlepoint.
